

# Pediatric Musculoskeletal Imaging: Beyond the Basics

## Target Audience

The target audience for this program includes radiologists involved in the imaging and care of pediatric and adolescent musculoskeletal injuries including sports medicine. This course is geared to pediatric, musculoskeletal, general radiologists, radiology trainees, and radiology and ultrasound technologists.

## Objectives

Upon completion of this course, participants will be able to:

- ◆ Recognize common disorders and apply advanced techniques in pediatric and adolescent musculoskeletal CT and MRI.
- ◆ List at least three unique issues related to pediatric and adolescent sports medicine from the perspective of the pediatric radiologist and pediatric orthopedic surgeon.
- ◆ Describe clinical situations where one might use each of these three applications for pediatric MSK sonography: basic, advanced, and emerging.
- ◆ Describe how to effectively develop a musculoskeletal interventional practice related to juvenile idiopathic arthritis and MR arthrography.
